

## **Information about Almonte**

Almonte, an Andalusian town with more than 20,000 inhabitants, is located between the wine-growing countryside of the Huelva county and the famous Guadalquivir marshes. The horizontal landscape, the sun, the light and the sea salt have given these lands the special charm of beauty in its simplicity. Vineyards and olive groves, holm oaks and pines, preserves, dunes, marshes and beaches come together in this border corner of old Andalusia, breaking traditional labels and stereotypes, to offer the visitor a new face of the south. Imbued with Mediterranean and Atlantic sauce, it is characterised by tranquillity, joy, calm and the transmission of a centuries-old way of living.

Within the area is the hamlet of [El Rocío](#), where the most famous procession of the country is held; and [Matalascañas](#), the most important tourist resort of the province.

Apart from the aforementioned Almonte's in the halfway between two important capital cities in Andalusia, that is to say, between the cities of Huelva and Seville. This offers you a wide range of possibilities when travelling, sightseeing or commuting.

## **Getting to Our School**

Our school is located in the centre of Almonte at Héroes de Baler St, 6. In the same street it is located as well 'Peña Flamenca' and we share the building with the House of Culture.

The closest airports are Seville and Faro (Portugal). To get to Almonte from Seville (the easiest and most common option) you've got different options:

- b) By train. The problem of this option is that trains only stop at La Palma del Condado (a neighbouring town). Once there you need to look for another way to get to Almonte, either taxi or Bla Bla Car).

- c) By Bla Bla Car. Perhaps one of the cheapest and easiest ways to get to Almonte. Most people carpooling travel from Seville to Bollullos (or the other way around) but, since Bollullos is not far from Almonte, you can always get a taxi at a nice price.

## Accommodation
